Terms and Conditions

1. Intellectual Property protection

- Te Punga Marutau (TPM) is the intellectual property of Recreation Aotearoa.
- All content, design, and materials associated with TPM are protected.
- You may not copy, modify, reproduce, or distribute TPM in any form without the prior written consent from Recreation Aotearoa.

2. Use of Te Punga Marutau

- TPM must be used solely within your registered organisation.
- TPM is to be implemented in a way that aligns with the intended kaupapa and principles.
- Any commercial use, reselling, sublicensing, or repurposing of TPM is strictly prohibited.

3. Training and support

- All intended users must complete an introductory training session before using TPM. It is your organisation's responsibility to ensure all users have completed this training before implementation.
- Ongoing support will be provided to ensure TPM is used correctly and respectfully.

4. No redistribution

- You may not share TPM materials, files, or resources externally without the prior written consent of Recreation Aotearoa.
- TPM is designed as a guided experience, and its effectiveness relies on controlled implementation.

5. Liability disclaimer

- Recreation Aotearoa is not liable for any unintended outcomes resulting from the use of TPM, to the fullest extent permitted by New Zealand law.
- Your organisation takes full responsibility for how TPM is used within your team.

6. Compliance and review

- By registering as a participant, you agree to adhere to these terms and respect the integrity of TPM.
- Recreation Aotearoa reserves the right to revoke access and require the return or deletion of all TPM materials if the tool is misused.

- Te Punga Marutau is in a developmental phase. As we continue to test and refine the resource, the pricing structure and access model may be reviewed. Any changes will be communicated with transparency and in good faith to those already involved.

Definitions

For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions:

- **Te Punga Marutau (TPM)** means the game, resources, tools, and supporting materials created and owned by Recreation Aotearoa.
- **Organisation** means the registered member organisation of Recreation Aotearoa that has signed up to use TPM.
- **User** means any person within your organisation who is authorised to access and use TPM.
- **Kaupapa** means the purpose, values, and guiding principles of TPM as intended by Recreation Aotearoa.
- **Materials** means all written, visual, digital, or printed content, files, tools, and resources provided as part of TPM.
- **Commercial use** means any activity where TPM or its materials are sold, licenced, sublicenced, distributed, or otherwise used for financial or business gain.
- **Misuse** means using TPM in a way that breaches these Terms and Conditions, including unauthorised sharing, modification, commercialisation, or any use that undermines its kaupapa.
